NASHVILLE, TN—Free Will Baptist Bible College will sponsor a seven-part “Ministry Wives” event on campus this fall, according to Mrs. Melinda Pinson, series hostess and wife of President Matt Pinson. The special sessions for FWBBC’s women students and recent graduates will meet Thursday evenings in the President’s Home beginning September 18.
