Continue with the Card Catalog:

***ATHENA CATALOG: Look up books in our library or e-books on your topic. Dewey numbers of note would include: 780's (Music), 927.8's (Biography of Musicians) & 264.2 (Music in public worship).

***MUSIC CATALOG beside water fountain has author, title and subject listing of recordings and sheet music. These include records, tapes and CDs, which are located on first floor of the stacks. The Sara Lacey Nicholas collection is distinguishable by the "N" at the beginning of the call number and its green card stock. These materials do not circulate.

Check the Periodicals:

MUSIC INDEX, though you must check each month separately, provides the best subject access to music periodicals. For church or Christian music, also check the CHRISTIAN PERIODICAL INDEX. For music education topics, also check EDUCATION INDEX. A search of TENNESSEE ELECTRONIC LIBRARY on the library network may also provide other articles.

Following is a list of music periodicals to which the library has current subscriptions. Other periodicals, however, may also deal with musical topics. Also, there may be backfiles of some periodicals on the third floor, though we do not currently subscribe. These are listed in notebooks both at the circulation desk and in the second floor periodical room.
